




- 1 pear per person
- Cinnamon or cinnamon sugar




Procedure: ASK A GROWNUP TO HELP YOU!

1. Ask your grownup to slice the pears in half, remove the core and the seeds.
2. Place the pear halves in a microwave-safe bowl or plate.
3. Sprinkle cinnamon or cinnamon sugar to coat the pear halves.
4. Microwave for 1 and a half to 2 minutes, until pears are tender.

You can serve them as is or enjoy with vanilla bean ice cream.






