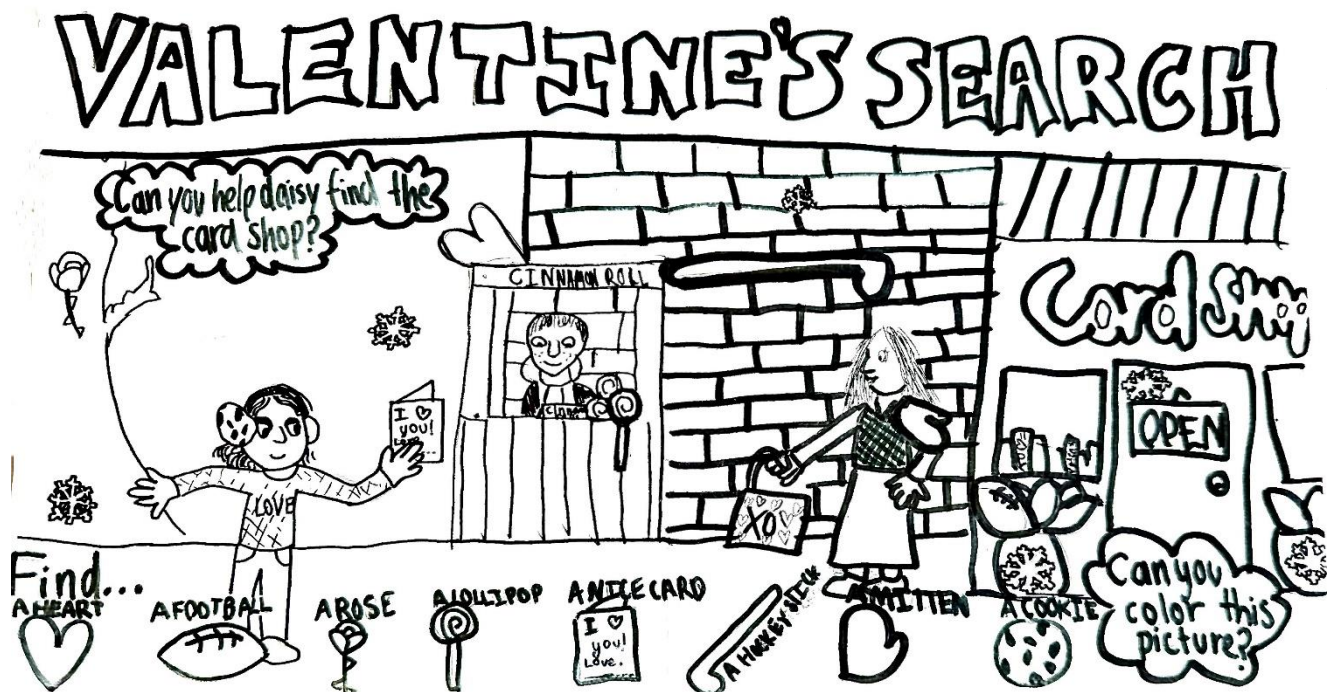
"Who bought this card?" she asked.
