was coming around.



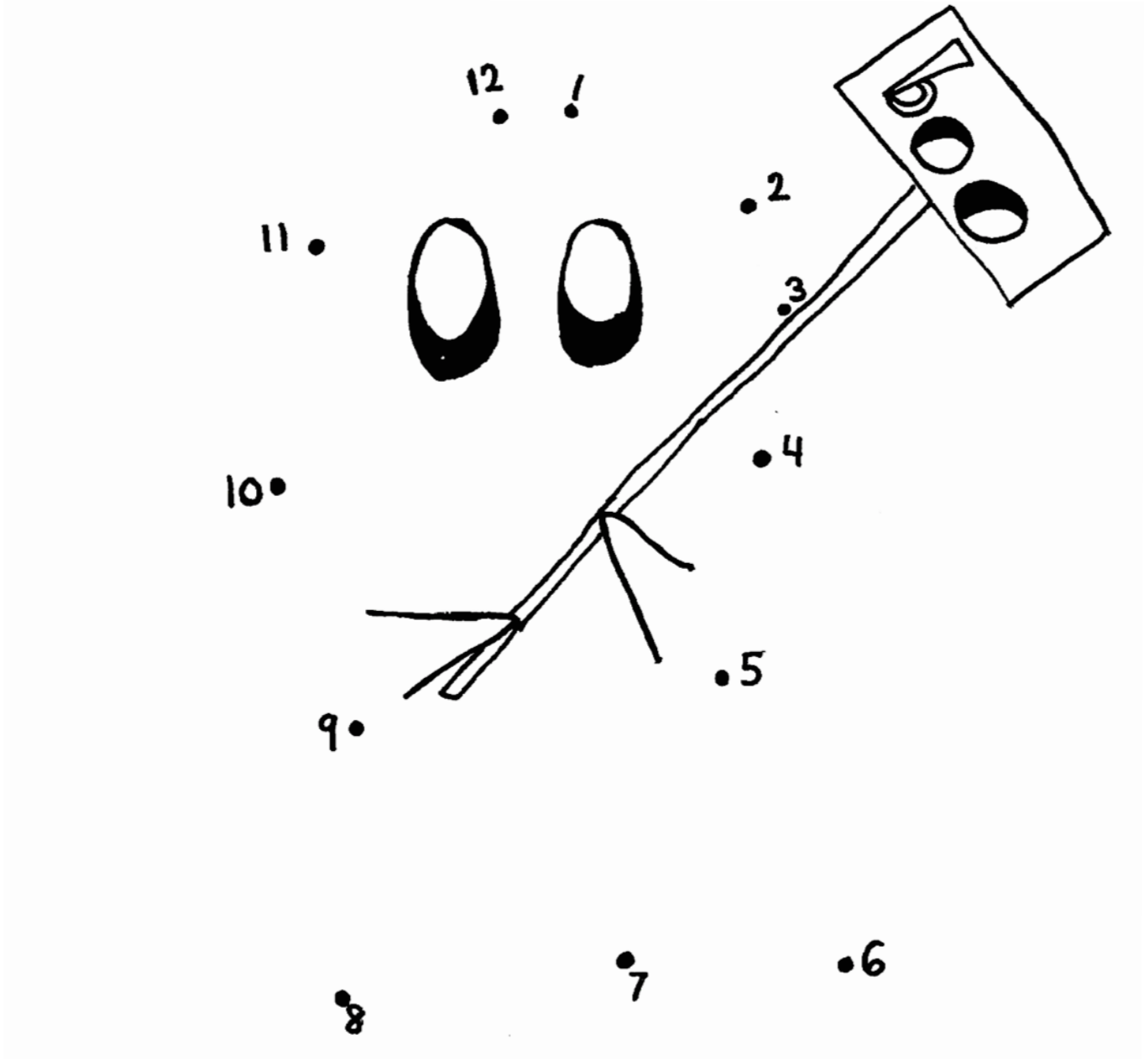
Bob and Cat

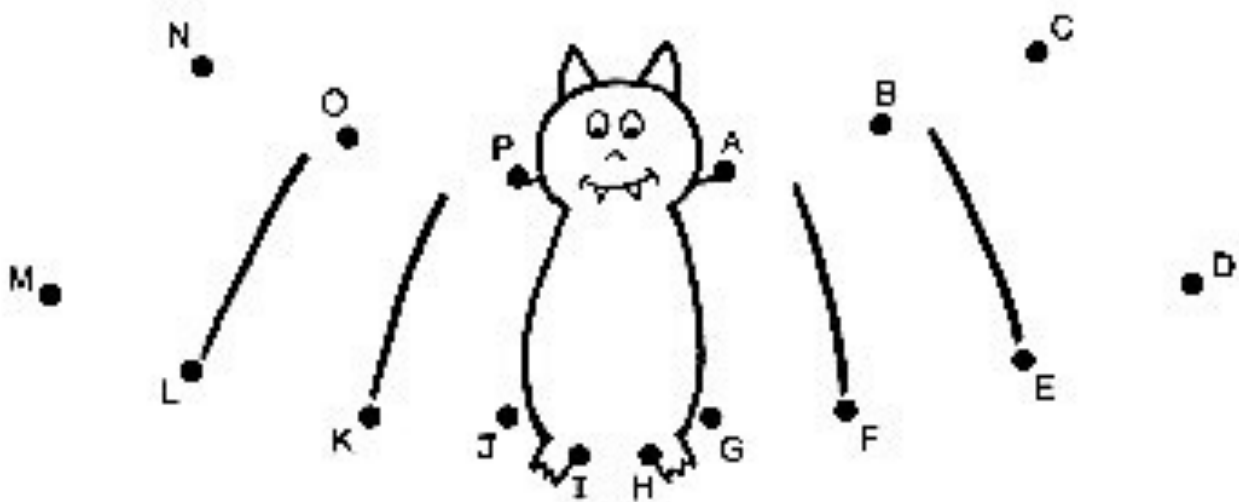
